### 1. GOVERNING BODY ELECTIONS

### 2. ABSENTEES AND LEARNERS ARRIVING LATE

Learners are completing assessments on a daily basis. The fact that they are only at school every other day makes it virtually impossible to catch up on assessments when a learner is absent. This can have a very negative effect on a learner's academic progress. Parents are therefore asked to not let their children stay at home unnecessarily.

The late arrival of learners remains a frustration that also has a negative effect on academics. The tendency is that they are mostly the same learners. Assessments in certain subjects start during the first period. Learners who arrive late cannot get extra time, as the period is only 30 minutes. The school will not accept responsibility for learners who are unable to complete their assessment because they arrive late.

### 3. STATIONERY

Learners are not bringing their stationery to school. This creates disruptions in class. **Learners are not allowed to share their stationery.**
